Dr. John Hooper is Professor of Music at Concordia University College of Alberta. He established the handbell program at Concordia, having conducted the Concordia Handbell Ensemble and Jubilo!, Dr. Hooper was a featured conductor at the 2008 Ringing Link in London, Ontario. He was invited by the Handbell Guilds of Canada to be the Canadian conductor at the International Handbell Symposium in Brisbane, Queensland, Australia in August 2006. There he also taught masterclasses on advanced conducting technique. His conducting teaching continued at the 2008 International Handbell Symposium and the National Seminar held in Orlando, Florida, USA, sponsored by the American Guild of English Handbell Ringers. He has written and arranged music for handbells, choirs, and other instruments. His Toccata won the Alberta Guild of English Handbell Ringers composition contest in 2003.

Singspiration

Established in 2000, the Concordia School of Music annually sponsors *Singspiration*, a summer choral music camp for youth entering grades 4-12. Starting in 2002, a **Ringspiration** component using handbells was added thanks to the support of the Alberta Guild of English Handbell Ringers.
