The *Classic Bronze Handbell Festival* is a massed ringing event that features advanced handbell ringers from across Alberta, Canada, and the US ringing challenging Level 3/4/5 music. Ringers rehearse together in Edmonton for three days, performing for the public on the final day. In the course of the festival, ringers challenge themselves and expand their abilities, and subsequently bring their experience back to their home choirs.

Guest conductor **Kevin McChesney's** arrangements and original compositions are favourites with handbell choirs everywhere. He is a talented composer, arranger, and musician and is in constant demand as conductor and clinician world-wide. Kevin McChesney conducts the *Pikes Peak Ringers*, one of North America's premier handbell ensembles.

The *Classic Bronze 2010* choir performs today on three core handbell sets, ranging from 4 to 6.5 octaves, augmented by three chime sets (ranging from 4 to 6.5 octaves).
