Guest conductor **Dr. Joy Berg**, associate professor at Concordia University College of Alberta (Edmonton), has been choral conductor for the three Concordia choirs (Concert Choir, Community Chorus and Bella Voce Women’s Choir) as well as the Concordia Ringers (student handbell ensemble), is the chapel Cantor for the daily chapel services, teaches church music classes, and is the artistic director for the Concordia Symphony Orchestra. Dr. Berg has been a guest conductor for Jubilo! Bells of Concordia, and has provided handbell workshops and adjudication around Alberta; she has also been the director (2001-2006) for Singspiration (Concordia’s choral/handbell summer camp for youth). Currently, Joy is the president for region 4 of the Association of Lutheran Church Musicians, sings alto with Pro Coro Canada (Edmonton’s professional choir), and serves as a board member for ICPM (Inner City Pastoral Ministry) in Edmonton. Joy has just returned from her sabbatical, where she focused on research and discussion within Europe into congregational singing and the leadership of that song.

The **Classic Bronze 2012** choir performs today on two core handbell sets, ranging from 4 to 6.5 octaves, augmented by two chime sets (ranging from 4 to 6.5 octaves).
